WR SEAN BAILEY, QB MATTHEW STAFFORD, TB KNOWSHON MORENO

Opening Statement from Sean Bailey: "It is truly an honor to be here playing in the Sugar Bowl. We are looking forward to playing Hawaii and we think it is going to be a great game."

Opening Statement from Matthew Stafford: "I am excited to be here in New Orleans. We are playing a good team and I think this is going to be a fun game to watch. It is a good opportunity for us to be playing in this game."

Opening Statement from Knowshon Moreno: "I have to agree with everyone, it is exciting to be here."

Question for Knowshon Moreno – What are your thoughts on some of the comparisons that have been made to you and Herschell Walker? "It really means a lot. He is a great guy and a great player. To be compared to a guy on that level is really special."

Question for Knowshon Moreno – What do you think your running style is and what are some of your influences? "I just kind of think I take a few things from different running backs. My favorite running back has always been Walter Payton. I just loved the way he ran the ball and admired his work ethic. I am not sure I really know what my personal style is."

Question for Matthew Stafford – What is going to be the key to moving the ball against Hawaii's defense? "I think that recognizing blitzes will be important. It will be important for me to make decisions on what guys need to be blocked. They do a lot of stuff that other teams do, but there are things we haven't seen yet."

Question for Sean Bailey – Hawaii has embraced the underdog role all season and in this game, how do you see that and do you see your team being the favorites? "I think we may have fallen into that trap against West Virginia two years ago in the Sugar Bowl. I think that they are definitely capable of beating us if we are not prepared. Hawaii is the team that is 12-0 so I think that they have just as good of a chance of winning as we do."

Question for Sean Bailey – How do you see the game playing out going against Hawaii? "As an offense we want to come out and control the ball and keep their offense off of the field as much as possible. I think our defense is better than it was when we were in the Sugar Bowl in 2005. I also think that their defense is better now than it was last year. I guess you really don't know what is going to happen until the game starts."
