Opening Statement from Marcus Howard: “My trip to New Orleans has been a great trip. It is a great city. All of the players love Bourbon Street. The food is very good. Hawaii is going to be a great team to play. They are 12-0 and should be a good team to compete against.”

Question for Jeff Owens – Is it difficult on a trip to a fun city like New Orleans to balance business/pleasure? – “One thing the coaches have stressed is that we are on a business trip. You have to be able to separate business from pleasure. We are here for one thing and one thing only and that is football. If it weren’t for football we wouldn’t be here. We are here to take care of business.”

Question for Marcus Howard – Will you be able to rush the QB with the amount of passes that Hawaii attempts? – “We know Hawaii is going to come out and throw the ball nearly 50 times. I mean they pass ninety percent of the time. This is the type of game that the defensive line dreams of; you know, getting a great pass rush and trying to disrupt the quarterback.”
